Topics to be addressed will include explanations of heating oil assistance, winterization and energy auditing programs. There will also be a round table discussion on how our local community can assist each other this winter.

We encourage the Bath Community, including other area churches to attend" said Pastor Steve Rowe, Pastor of First Baptist.
